1. Introduction

YAPC::Europe (Yet Another Perl Conference) is the biggest annual Perl conference in Europe. Since 2000, local user groups organise this non-profit event in different European cities. This time Vienna.pm submitted the most convincing offer for 2007's YAPC and put behind the proposals from Lyon and Pisa. Thus, YEF (YAPC::Europe Foundation, http://www.yapceurope.org/) mandated Vienna.pm to organise YAPC::Europe 2007.

YAPC conferences are usually attended by 200 to 250 Perl developers from all over the world. Approximately 50 speakers offer a multitude of talks to various Perl-related themes in three parallel session over three days. During the whole conference there is a constant, intense and often informal exchange of ideas between the attendees. Besides Perl, a lot of general software development topics like testing, Agile Methods, Unicode, project management, version control software, Object-oriented Programming and much more are discussed.

At YAPC::Europe 2007 we plan to host Hackathons, which are a moderated workshops with a specific topic, where experienced users and newbies can get together and share experience, improve parts of the featured project or step through some project internals.

YAPC::Europe 2007 will take place from 28th to 30st August 2007 at the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration (WU-Wien, http://www.wu-wien.ac.at/english/).

Even though the YAPC is planned and realised by the Perl community itself, sponsoring by local and international organisations and companies is not only wished for, but necessary.

YAPC is a grassroots-organised conference with very inexpensive attendance fees (100 Euros for three days of conference, including coffee breaks and a attendees dinner). The organisers mostly have to spend their free time for doing organising work. Only very few have been granted to work on the conference organisation as part of their regular job. No member of the organiser team will get any monetary refund for their work.

After the end of the early bird registration period at March 31st, there are already 140 people registered at the website.

2. Why sponsor YAPC::Europe 2007?

 Audrey Tang and Mark Jason Dominus to YAPC::Europe 2007. Maybe one of them can be convinced to hold a 'private' (or 'corporate') seminar.
- Or you could fund travel costs of other renowned members of the Perl community you would like to meet.
- YAPC::Europe brings together the know-how of Europe's leading Perl developers.
- YAPC::Europe offers the possibility to entertain discussions with other developers working in similar or different industries.
- YAPC::Europe offers the possibility to present your own ideas to more than 200 topclass developers from all over Europe.

As we have already noted, a potential profit will not be used for a holiday trip to the Caribbean by the organisers :-).

It will be split according to the following rules:

- A part of it will be donated to TPF (The Perl Foundation, http://www.perlfoundation.org/) to fund development of Perl 6 and Perl 5.
- A part of it stays at Vienna.pm to fund future Perl events in Austria (e.g. Perl Workshops, Tech-Meets, payment of travel expenses, etc.).
- A part of it will be used to fund future YAPC::Europe conferences by donating it to YEF (YAPC::Europe Foundation).

3. What could you sponsor?

4. What can we offer you?

We can offer:

- Presentation of information materials:

Exhibition

Exhibition space will be available all day during the last day of the conference, for sponsors and exhibitors to promote themselves. Space will be available in the foyer and in the main hall for both manned and unmanned promotional stands.

This will provide key sponsors with the opportunity to appear in person at the conference, to either promote their products and services or be used as a recruitment venture.

Exhibitors will also include notable Open Source Software projects and initiatives, with a view to providing a worthwhile experience for attendees by providing a full spectrum view of the industry.

5. Jobfair

On the second day of the conference. the 29th of August 2007, a job fair is taking place in the foyer of the venue from around 10:00 a. m. until 5.30 p. m.

Your company can get the unique opportunity to meet 200-250 Perl developers at one single spot for only 500€. The job fair package includes:

- a table in the foyer of the venue for one day (you can bring your own stand with up to 10m²)
- opportunity for a 5 minute company presentation in one of the smaller lecture rooms (not in the main lecture hall)
